ONGOING CAMPAIGN

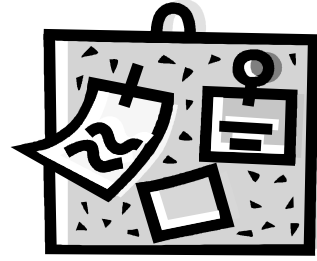
That's it, just one cent for each year!
